



Guidelines and Information for Speakers

Important dates

- From August 15th: Notification of acceptance of presentation
- From end of August: Confirmation of accepted presentations by speakers
- Until October 1st: Submission of paper and CV
- Until October 31st: Submission of presentation slides for translators
- November 17th or 18th: Give your presentation live online

In 8 steps to your presentation

- Step 1: Submission of an abstract
- Step 2: Receive a notification of acceptance
- Step 3: Definitely confirm your presentation by filling in the presentation form including your registration as speaker
- Step 4: Read the guidelines concerning paper and presentation (on the following pages)
- Step 5: Submission of paper and CV
- Step 6: Submission of your presentation for the translators
- Step 7: Test your presentation with the technical equipment online in trial meeting
- Step 8: Give your presentation online during event



Presentation

Your presentation lasts 20 minutes plus 10 minutes of subsequent discussion with the audience. You can choose Chinese or English as the language of your spoken presentation. We will test the live online presentation during a test meeting before the event. All oral presentations will be simultaneously translated by professional interpreters between English and Chinese. By following some basic rules you can help to ensure that your presentation will be translated optimally:

- Submission of your draft presentation slides for the translators on time until October 31st
- Avoid quick or unclear speaking
- You can further increase the quality of translation by handing in your speaker notes or transcript of your presentation
- Should your presentation contain a video, please send the video file to us as a separate file as well for back up

Presentation Slides

Please note, that presentation slides can only be accepted in English. All presentations are translated simultaneously between English and Chinese. You can use your own in-house PPT template.

Paper

- The Aachen Colloquium will publish conference proceedings containing all papers. With the acceptance of your presentation, you commit to the obligatory submission of a formulated English paper with a length of 8 to 36 pages based on the template. The publication of presentation slides is not intended. Please note the following guidelines:
- The author is solely responsible for the accuracy of the paper content. The organizer reserves the right to change the layout.
- Exclusion of competition: It is not permitted that the content of the presentation and the manuscript have been published elsewhere in the form in which they are submitted to the Aachen Colloquium.
- Transfer of rights: With submission of the paper, the Aachen Colloquium Sustainable Mobility acquires the unrestricted right of use for reproduction and distribution in all currently known forms of exploitation and for all types of use.

- The participation of further speakers and co-authors is not free of charge. They must register separately with the standard registration form.

Preparation before the Colloquium

- The event will use the tool „Zoom“ for the online conference. Please make sure this tool runs on your device.
- An online trial meeting will be organized. There you have the possibility to test out your settings. Please ensure that your camera and microphone are working.
- Choose an appropriate (virtual) background for your meeting and use good lightning.
- To ensure a smooth proceeding of your presentation and the conference, please be online on time before your presentation slot.
